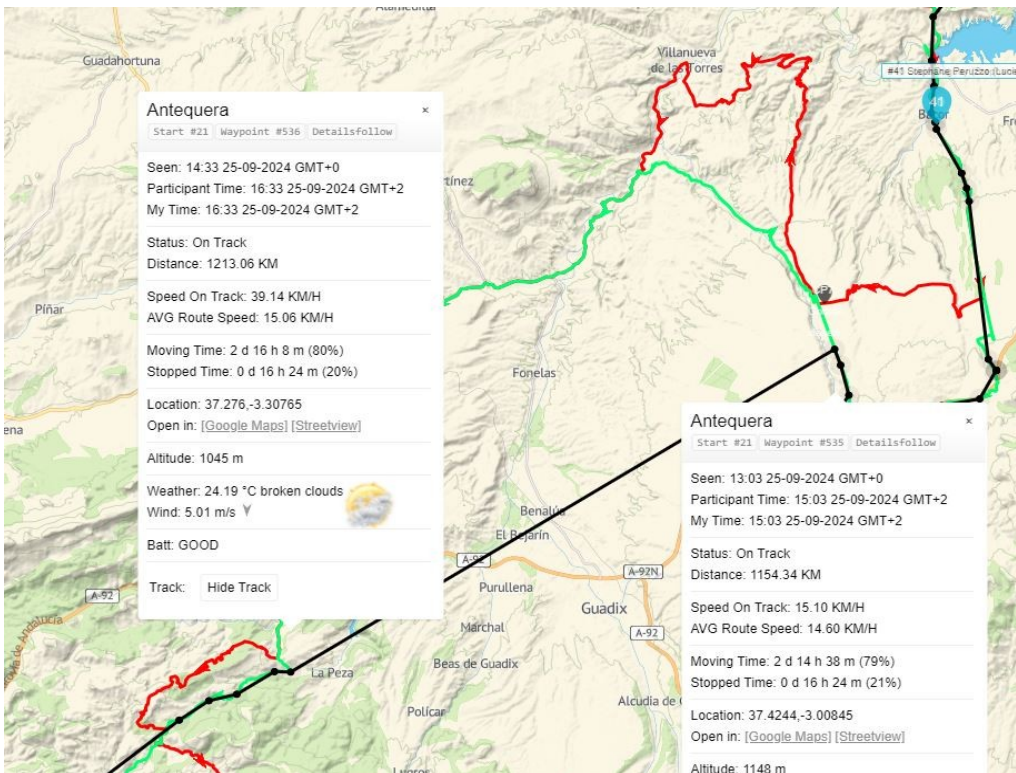

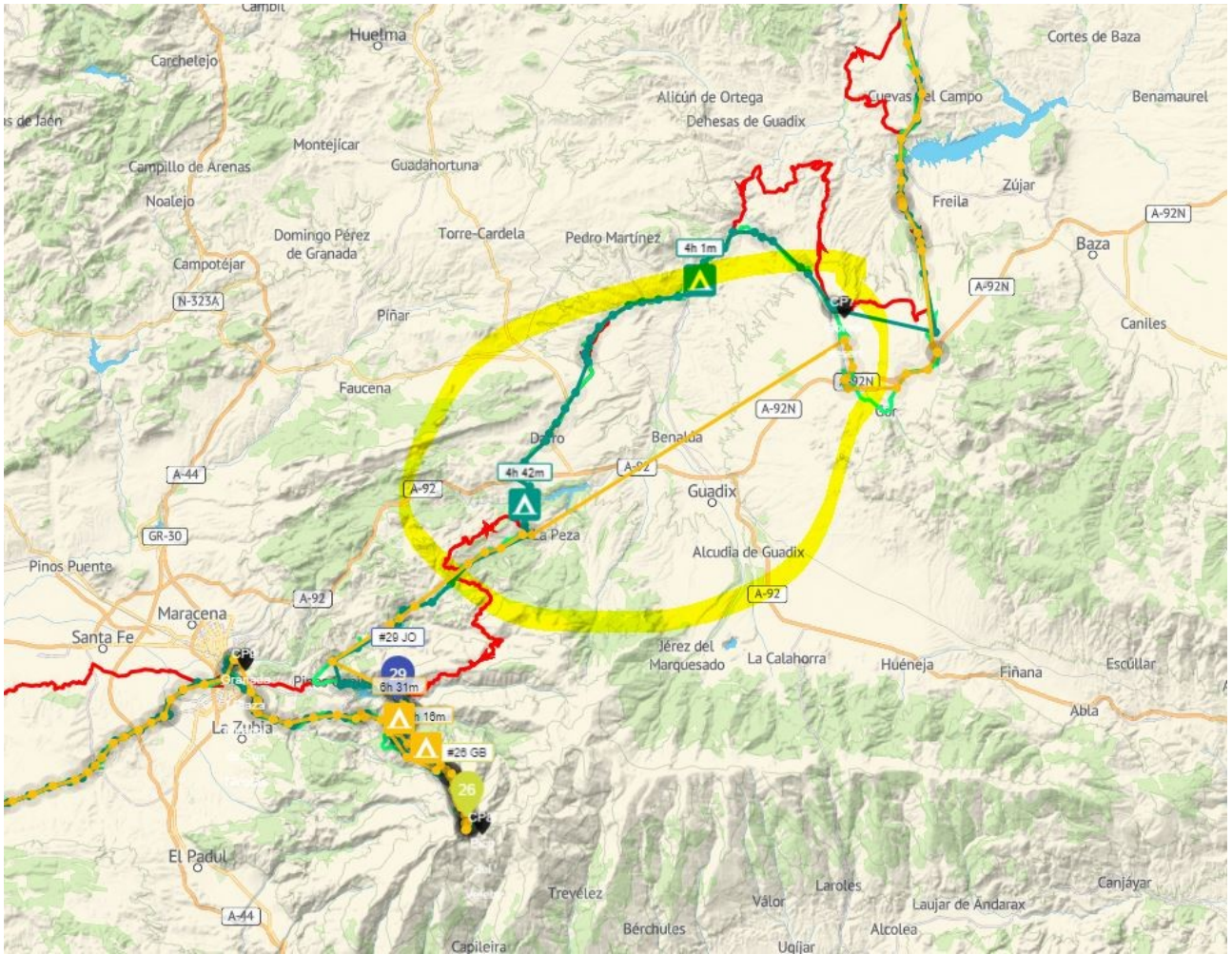

# Checkpoint Pico del Veleta: night ban

barrier, going up, 2520m:

Participant Time: 21:58 25-09-2024 GMT+2

barrier, coming down, 2520m:

Participant Time: 00:17 26-09-2024 GMT+2

The road routebook says:

**«Please note that for this checkpoint only selfies taken at daylight will be accepted! In the evening the selfie has to be taken around 19:30 latest. After you have immediately to descent down to the barrier at 2520m. In the morning you can take the selfie as soon you have enough light to take it without flash, that means around 08:00 earliest. You are not allowed to spend the night at a higher altitude then 2520m.»**
